

Creamy Cole Slaw

Servings: 12 Preparation Time: 20 minutes Start to Finish Time: 25 minutes

This is the best "traditional" cole slaw that I've made. A great accompaniment for sandwiches. There is plenty of creamy, rich dressing. Very colorful presentation!

DRESSING:

- 1 1/2 cups mayonnaise
- 1 1/2 cups sour cream
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon celery seeds
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon freshly ground pepper SLAW:
- 1 head green cabbage leaf, cored, shredded and chopped
- 2 cups celery, chopped
- 1 cup red bell pepper, seeded and diced
- 1 large carrot, grated
- 1 medium onion, diced



To make the dressing, combine the dressing ingredients an a small, non-reactive bowl and blend well with a wire whisk.

To make the slaw, combine the slaw ingredients in a large non-reactive bowl and blend well.

Pour the dressing over the slaw and toss to blend.

Serve cold.

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
